### September Board of Directors Meeting Announcements:

Due to ongoing low attendance at our monthly membership meetings, the board approved a change to our schedule beginning in 2023. The 2023 meeting schedule is as follows: February (annual business meeting), May, September, and December (Christmas party). If demand for monthly meetings return, we will resume our previous schedule of September through May. The plan currently is to serve a limited number of dinners at the meetings based on the previous meeting's number of meals served. If we do not at least breakeven on the meals then we will return to snacks only. These changes do not affect the remainder of 2022. We will have monthly membership meetings and dinners through the end of the year.

Membership renewals for 2023 start October 1st. Due to processing errors with PayPal we are not accepting PayPal this year. You should receive your renewal package by mid-October. Please review your documents closely and make any necessary corrections. You are required to return the completed application, test, and payment by December 31, 2022. If the renewal requirements are not satisfied by December 31, 2022 you will be required to attend a new member orientation in 2023 and pay the \$35 initiation fee. Should you wish to complete your test during one of the upcoming new member orientations you are welcome to join us Tuesday, October 18, Saturday, November 5, or Tuesday, December 13.

Sight in Days will run November 5th – 13th between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. This event is open to the public. The cost is \$5.00 per firearm. ### By-Law, Operating Policy, and Range Rule Reminder

By-Laws ARTICLE 8 - DUES

- A.** The Club annual dues for a General member shall be sixty-five (65) dollars plus MUCC dues (currently \$5), and shall cover the period of January first (1) through December thirty-first (31). If membership is applied for after September 30, the dues shall cover the period of October 1 of the current year through December 31 of the following year. In addition, there shall be an initiation fee equal to thirty-five (35) dollars for all new General membership applications. This initiation fee is suspended for membership applications received during the period July 1 through September 30. Amended 05/18/17
- B.** All regular members are required to be members of MUCC. Amended 11/10/16
- C.** The Club annual dues for an associate member shall be thirty-five (35) dollars and shall cover the period of January first (1) through December thirty-first (31). If associate membership is applied for after September 30, the dues shall cover the period October 1 of the current year through December 31 of the following year. Amended 05/18/17
- D.** Payments shall be accepted in full year increments only.

#### Club Rules

All members are required to present their membership card up on request.

All memberships expire December 31 of each year. Membership renewal is available online between Oct. 1st to Dec. 31st visit our [website](#) for details.

#### Club Shooting Hours

Are as follows, 8 AM until sunset, use the hunting guide to determine sunset. Organized events under lights may go to 10 PM. Lights on all ranges are for organized events only.

#### Guest

Is defined as anyone 18 years of age and older who are not an immediate family residing in the same household as the general member. Guests are required to pay the \$5.00 guest fee for each range used. Mailboxes are located on each range. Immediate family is defined as your spouse and children. Youth ages 17 and under shoot free while accompanied by a general member.

#### **ELECTRONIC GATES**

The electronic gates open and will close 30 seconds after fully open, if the gate begins to close and about to hit your car stop immediately. The gate will stop once it touches your car and retreat backwards without causing any damage. You will damage your vehicle if you continue. The club is not responsible!

Hunters may sight in rifles / hunting handguns while our volunteers help spot your shots, adjust your sights or scope and maintain safe conditions at and behind the firing line. You may sight in more than one firearm, and you are allowed to shoot enough to safely get zeroed in.

**\*\*Please note that we have no method for credit card use on our range facilities. Cash only please.\*\***

Distance options in yards: 25, 50, 100

Please sign in at the Pistol Garage across for the 50/100 yard ranges prior to going to the range and setting up. Shooting will stop at 4:00 PM. Please get there as early as you can before the last couple of days before the opening of deer season, as there can be quite a crowd. Saginaw Field and Stream Club provides bench rests, corn bags, targets and a volunteer to help you spot your shots on the targets.
