## PRESIDENT'S THOUGHTS



We held our Annual Sight in Days fundraiser November 5th to the 13th. We sighted-in 458 guns, which raised \$2,340 for the club. While I enjoyed hearing the positive feedback about the range while I volunteered, what I enjoyed hearing the most was the feedback I and the other volunteers received while I wasn't present. Most of the stories centered around how grateful the participants were for the assistance they received. Our staff did an amazing job with every aspect of the event. From bore sighting to repairs, to spotting to assist with scope adjustments our volunteers went the extra mile to ensure everyone left confident they'd be able to make any shot that presented. See you next year were the parting words of virtually everyone that came out, I know that I can speak for everyone involved when I say we certainly look forward to it. Thank you to the volunteers that donated their time and braved the elements to make sure everyone was ready for their next hunting adventure. Our volunteers are the heartbeat of our club, and they are what makes Saginaw Field and Stream so great.

While this event was successful overall, we did have a few members disappointed that members were also required to pay the \$5.00 per firearm fee. As a nonprofit we use events like Sight in Days to enable us to perform capital improvements without increasing dues. We also do our best to ensure that our ranges are available for members outside of event hours in this case from 4:00 p.m. until dusk. For the services rendered, many believe we are underpriced. Our ranges are rarely shutdown now due to the range improvements, but we still recommend that you check the monthly newsletter, yearly calendar event flyer, website, or website calendar to ensure you are able to utilize the ranges as intended upon your arrival. If you do not want to pay event fees, plan accordingly.

There are 31 days left in the 2022 membership renewal period. As you finalize your Christmas and New Year preparations don't procrastinate on your membership renewal like most people do on their Christmas shopping. If you miss the December 31st renewal deadline, you will be required to pay a \$35 initiation fee and attend our in-person member orientation on the third Tuesday of the month. Should you have extenuating circumstances that will prevent you from renewing by the deadline, but you intend on maintaining your membership, please contact either the Membership Secretary Mike Meyer or me PRIOR to the December 31st deadline. After the deadline, we will be unable to work with you to determine the best solution to avoid the additional fee / orientation requirement. December 31st is also the deadline to submit your nominations for any club member you would like recognized for their extraordinary volunteerism. That will allow the nominations committee ample time to review the nominees and prepare their respective recognition before our February 2023 business meeting. At a minimum, nominations should state why you believe your nominee should be recognized and provide an example (s) of support.

Since there is no January meeting, we will be accepting director nominations from the floor during this month's membership meeting. Our December 15th membership meeting will feature something for everyone. For adults we will have U.S. Law Shield as guest speaker in the Multi-Purpose Room and Santa Claus in the Clubhouse Hall handing out gifts to the kids 17 years-old and younger. I look forward to seeing you there!

Guests are required to pay the \$5.00 guest fee for each range used. Mailboxes are located on each range. Immediate family is defined as your spouse and children. Youth ages 17 and under shoot free while accompanied by a general member.

The electronic gates open and will close 30 seconds after fully open, if the gate begins to close and about to hit your car stop immediately. The gate will stop once it touches your car and retreat backwards without causing any damage. You will damage your vehicle if you continue. The club is not responsible!
