#### TRAP & SKEET REPORT by Mike Meyer

Our high school trap teams have finished their competition rounds for the Spring league. Valley Lutheran finished 2nd in their conference, just 6.5 points behind Hemlock. Both teams were almost 400 points better than the 3rd place team in the conference. Valley Lutheran had six shooters in the top 25 male shooters and two shooters in the top 10 female shooters.

Nouvel Catholic finished 3rd in their conference, with four male shooters and one female in the top 25.

In the thousands of shooters throughout the state, our two teams had 5 shooters in the top 100. Collin Engelhardt (VL) and Ryan Quackenbush (NC-F) were tied for 30th, Ben Tomandl (VL) was 39th, Rylee Ross (VL) was 70th and Ryan McDonald (NC-F) was 82nd.

Now the High School shooters have to practice for the State Tournament on June 17, and the National Championship on July 5-9. Both shoots will be held on the MTA grounds at Mason, Michigan.

#### Bullseye--Precision Pistol Fundamentals by Brian Miller

- 1. Stance—The stance is primarily perpendicular to the target while making it comfortable. Rotate your stance so your red dot or iron sights are centered in the Bull.
- 2. Grip—The grip must be firm like a firm handshake but not to the point of causing tremors.
- 3. Sight Picture—This must be consistent each and every time whether it's a center of bull alignment or a 6 O'clock hold.
- 4. Trigger Pull—must be an uninterrupted pulling of the trigger until the pistol fires *while not moving the sight pic-ture*. Generally, if you take the shot when it looks right the shot will be somewhere outside of the black. Usually low, left.

If the Bullseye shooter performs these fundamentals for each and every shot, it will be a good scoring shot. This can also be applied to any shooting discipline not just Bullseye. Hope this helps other shooters.

## Saginaw Field & Stream Club 2023 Hunter Safety Class

Hunter education trains new hunters to be safe, legal and responsible hunters. Topics covered include understanding wildlife management, wildlife identification, ethics, laws and regulations, and firearms safety and handling. In order to purchase a hunting license in Michigan, individuals born on or after January 1, 1960, is required to successfully complete a hunter education course.

This traditional course will take place over two days, with the first day being in the classroom and second being a field day. Attendance is required for both days. There is no minimum age requirement; however, students under 10 years of age shall be accompanied by a parent, legal guardian or other adult approved by the parent or legal guardian. 
