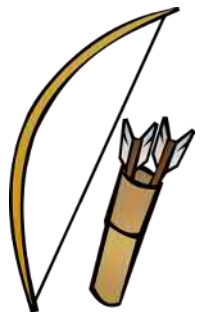
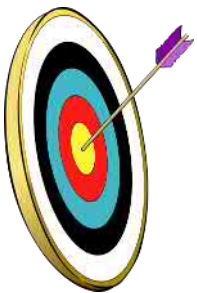

Chris Haver Memorial Junior Scholarship Program

Beginning in 2024, the Chris Haver Memorial Fund is looking to sponsor “junior” shooters.
