PRESIDENT'S THOUGHTS

My fellow members,

It's amazing how fast the leaves changed and are falling now. Hopefully all the hunters have been able to get out and enjoy some of the beautiful weather we've been having. I'm looking forward to November 15th. Speaking of firearm deer season, we will be hosting our annual sight in days at the 50-yd and 100-yd range starting November 2nd, please see the website for full details.

Renewals are coming in quite steadily, if you haven't received yours in the mail yet, please reach out to me or the membership secretary, Mike Meyer, and we will get you one. If you plan on using your credit card by mail, please include the 3-digit code on the back of the card. We recently installed a new point of sale system at the clubhouse and were unaware of this change.

The Highschool trap teams are finishing up their fall season and we are still selling 3-gun tickets until the December meeting. Please stop by the clubhouse and get yours before they are gone. Remember these proceeds benefit the youth shooters directly.

Over the past couple of months, the board of directors have been discussing some of our By-Laws. We feel the following proposed amendments will give our members more input on board appointments and update new membership requirements. Listed below are the proposed amendments that will be presented during our December 12th, 2024, membership meeting and to be voted on at our annual business meeting February 20th, 2025.

1. Article 3, Part A, will read "The club board of directors shall consist of twenty-one (21) elected members herein referred to as 'the board'. All members of the board must be club members in good standing.
2. Article 3, Part C line 4, At the regular membership meeting, preceding the annual meeting, the presiding officer shall call for floor nominations.
3. Article 6, Part D, Past presidents who have successfully completed at least three (3) one-year terms of president, at the expiration of their third term as president shall become permanent life members of the club, subject to club rules covered elsewhere within the constitution and bylaws. All previous single-term past presidents is grandfathered for life membership.
4. Article 6, Part E, Application for membership in the club may be made at scheduled membership orientation meetings, with payment of the appropriate fees, a membership card shall be issued. Final approval is subject to a three-quarters vote of the board.
5. Article 8, Part A, line 3, If membership is applied for after September 1, the dues shall cover the period of September 1, of the current year through December 31 of the following year. In addition, there shall be an initiation fee equal to thirty-five (35) dollars for all new general membership applications. This initiation fee is suspended for membership applications received during the period July 1 through August 31.
6. Article 8, Part B, line 2, If associate membership is applied for after September 1, the dues shall cover the period September 1 of the current year through December 31 of the following year.

By the time you read this, our Fall High School Trap League will be over, and the trap fields will be less busy. We're extremely proud of all of these young shooters. We had a generous donation from Jay's Sporting Goods in Clare of a Mossberg Bantam 20 Gauge Semi-Auto shotgun for our High School Clay target teams. Frank's Great Outdoors donated a Winchester 20 gauge youth semi -auto shotgun. The semi-autos have less recoil and are popular with our smaller shooters.



Just a reminder, our trap and skeet fields will be open through the winter on our regular days of Tuesday (2-6 PM) and Saturday (8:30 – Noon). Keep in mind that our 10 round Punch Cards make great Christmas presents.

Our Hunter Sight In Days is a 9 day event, event is open to the public and club members. Hunters may sight in their rifles / hunting handguns while our volunteers help spot your shots, adjust your sights or scope and maintain safe conditions at and behind the firing line. You may sight in more than one firearm, and you are allowed to shoot enough to safely get zeroed in.

****Please note that we have no method for credit card use on our range facilities. Cash only please.****

Distance options in yards: 25, 50, 100

Please sign in at the 50/100 yard ranges prior to going to a bench and setting up. Shooting will stop at 4:00 PM. Please get there as early as you can before the last couple of days before the opening of deer season, as there can be quite a crowd. Saginaw Field and Stream Club will provide bench rest, support bags, spotting scope, and targets. When possible with enough volunteer a spotter.

"Sight In Days" is an important part of Saginaw Field and Stream Club annual fundraising. Everyone out there helping is a volunteer please be courteous and patient. If you're a member, and don't want to pay the \$5.00 sight in fee during the event hours, then sight-in prior to the event or after 4 pm on the event days.

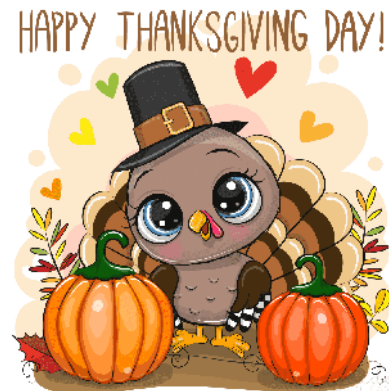
